# Campaign theme: Collaboration with a school for the hearing impaired to protect the environment

The young people chose the Pavol Sabadoš United Boarding School.

The Pavol Sabadoš United Boarding School is a school dedicated to the education of hearing-impaired children and young people. The school provides comprehensive education in an environment adapted to the needs of deaf and hearing-impaired pupils, including teaching in Slovak Sign Language.

## Implementation

The workshop focused on the Deaf Climate Action (DCA) project, which demonstrates the accessibility of environmental education for the hearing impaired through:

- Simplified language – environmental topics presented in an easily understandable form
- Slovak Sign Language – all materials available in sign language
- Digital tools – an app, videos and a CO<sup>2</sup> test adapted for deaf users

## Sustainable cooperation – network building

The Pavol Sabadoš United Boarding School will integrate the Deaf Climate Action project materials directly into its teaching. Specific steps for sustainable cooperation:

- 1) Teaching pupils in accordance with the school curriculum using DCA materials
- 2) Implementation of materials in Slovak Sign Language directly into teaching
- 3) Raising environmental awareness among hearing-impaired children and pupils at the school

## Creation of 3 VLOGS

Finally, a group of young people from the DeafStudio organisation filmed three short video blogs using a mobile phone camera. What matters is the message the videos convey.

The first video carries a message about climate change and waste. A small change in everyday life can protect most of what we care about. My message for the future!

The second video focuses on the problem of plastic waste. Every day, we use plastic for just a few minutes—bottles, straws, bags, packaging—and then throw it away. Plastic remains in the environment for years and harms both animals and people. The solution is simple: bring your own bottle, cloth bag, and food container. All it takes is one small change. Small change = big difference.

The third video focuses on saving electricity. Electricity is a part of everyday life—but we often waste it: lights are left on, chargers are left plugged in, and TVs are left on standby. More energy consumption means more pollution and a greater burden on the planet. Yet making a change is simple: turn off the lights, unplug the charger, turn off the TV. A small step. A big change
